The South West has received over £595 million from the National Lottery so far. This transfers as £146 per head of the population, 6% more than the UK average.

There is less money available for new projects so applicants will face tougher competition than ever before. Fund-seekers need to ensure they can supplement their Lottery grant with money from other sources such as Europe; partnership working is becoming an increasingly important part of every Lottery bid.

As well as providing an opportunity to learn about constructing partnership bids and accessing European funds, the South West Conference will be a rare opportunity for a cross-distributor approach to the Lottery, allowing people to catch up on the latest policy and programme developments and problem-solve with distributors, consultants or peers. It will be an ideal platform to share best practice, create new contacts and learn from previously successful projects and will offer valuable insider advice on putting together a winning bid.
